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<p><b>Authorized Amendment</b></p> <p>Summary / Overview of the amendment to explain/ensure that the reader understands: the rationale for the amendment; the major changes; and, importantly, the full context (including desired outcome) of the amendment.</p> <p><b>The Regulated Community is reminded to check this amendment against any applicable AAMC, Waivers or Exemptions to ensure their ongoing validity.</b></p> <p>An MAA Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) was established to conduct a review of key 1200 Series RAs (specifically RA 1200, RA 1205, RA 1210, RA 1220, and RA 1225) in order to generate greater consistency, coherency and clarity in Air Safety Management Regulation, and to reduce ‘white space’ between independent regulation within the 1200 Series RAs (eg: Clearer lines drawn between the ASSC and ASMS (including risk management, information management and the role/responsibilities of ADH-facing organizations)).</p> <p>The review also aimed to incorporate the changes introduced by the release of the 1160 Series RAs, major changes introduced in RA 1205 Issue 7, and the 2020 revision of the 5000 Series RAs.</p> <p>The Type Airworthiness contents of RA 1220 have been transferred to the 5000 Series RAs (specifically the following new RAs: RA 5010, RA 5011, RA 5012, RA 5013, and RA 5407), and thus RA 1220 has been withdrawn.</p> <p>RA 1225 – Air Safety Documentation Audit Trail:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clarity on the use of electronic documentation.</li> <li>• Clarity on the use of security classification / handling instructions, and the need to identify significant Air Safety related documentation.</li> </ul>
