I object to the above proposed development sited above.

This site which is the last green space in the village and located in the historic heart of Elsenham, which as a 'village' has already too many developments around it which will adversely impact listed building. Developing here in within the Stansted Airport Countryside Protection Zone here will have a detrimental affect on the countryside wildlife already disappearing as they are squeezed out of the surrounds of the Village.

The village has already planning approval to more than double in size since 2011 with no extra facilities in terms of doctors surgery, school places, train service nor cope with the extra road traffic. There are no plans from any of these organisations to improve these services.

There is no sustainable employment in this village that would not involve people moving to these houses to have to drive to work, These are still country lanes in and out of Elsenham and are not suitable for the continuing pressure of construction traffic, the number of animals being killed, potholes and tremors on the old buildings is not sustainable.
