I am writing to register my objections on the above Planning Application.

Objection :

TRAFFIC

The main road from Henham and Elsenham is very narrow with high congestion approaching the traffic lights into Stansted Mountfitchet from Elsenham particularly at peak periods and school times.

The road also has a lot of deep potholes which are impossible to avoid.

There is residents parking immediately before the traffic lights causing single file traffic and chaos. Only experienced residents understand the need to stop 500 yards or more back to queue in order for oncoming traffic to get through.

Large trucks use the road from the Elsenham side as there is no restriction, thus causing the road to be completely blocked to standstill for a long time.

So, with the already over development of what was a small village, the route is totally overloaded.

The recent approval for yet another 500 houses which could produce another 1000 cars was granted without proper and due consideration .

Any more development would be madness.

Emergency vehicles already have problems. The serious results of adding to this chaos could prove to be dire.

Objection:

OVER DEVELOPMENT OF VILLAGES

Elsenham has more than doubled in size in just a few years from the quiet historic English village to virtually a small town. The density of the development is horrendous and this latest proposal would build on the last piece of green space in the heart of the Village not far from the historical Elsenham Cross.

This is nothing but sheer greed by developers who are destroying the Village and wildlife.
