## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE DISMISSALS AND REINSTATEMENTS.

We refer to your email dated 6 December 2021 to the Ministry of Defence Police which was acknowledged on the same date.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

How many officers have been dismissed from the force in the last 4 years 11 months (1st Jan 2017 -1st December 2021, but have then gone on to be reinstated after a successful appeal of their dismissal, also can you give details of what the original dismissal in all cases was for. Can you provide the figures for each year in a separate tabulation? The information is only required for police officers and special constables.

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request. (Please note the Ministry of Defence Police does not employ special constables).

One officer was dismissed in 2019 under the Ministry of Defence Police (Performance) Regulations 2012 for 'Attendance'. The officer was reinstated following an appeal to a Police Appeal Tribunal.

Please note that any request for an internal review should be made within 40 working days of the date of this response.
