### **II.1** Animal health attestation

I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the fresh meat described in Part I:

- **II.1.1** comes from a country or region authorized for imports into Great Britain as laid down in a document relating to 'fresh meat of ungulates' published on gov.uk, in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 206/2010<sup>(3)</sup> at the time of slaughter, and
- **II.1.2** complies with the relevant animal health conditions as laid down in the animal health attestation in the model certificate [BOV][OVI] [POR] [EQU] [RUF] [RUW] [SUF] [SUW][EQW]<sup>(1)</sup> in the form published by the appropriate authority from time to time, and

References to European Union legislation within this certificate are references to direct EU legislation which has been retained in Great Britain (retained EU law as defined in the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018) and can be viewed on the UK legislation website (legislation.gov.uk).

References to Great Britain in this certificate include Channel Islands and Isle of Man.

This certificate is meant for transit and storage in accordance with Article 19 of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2124 of:

- fresh meat, including minced meat, of:

- (1) domestic bovine animals (including Bubalus and Bison species and their cross-breeds) (Model 'BOV');
- (2) domestic ovine animals (Ovis aries) or domestic caprine animals (Capra hircus) (Model 'OVI');
- (3) domestic porcine animals (Sus scrofa) (Model 'POR');
- fresh meat, excluding minced meat, of:

(4) domestic solipeds (Equus caballus, Equus asinus and their cross-breeds) (Model 'EQU');

- fresh meat, excluding offal and minced meat, of:

(5) farmed non-domestic animals of the order *Artiodactyla* (excluding bovine animals (including *Bison* and *Bubalus* species and their cross-breeds), *Ovis aries, Capra hircus, Suidae* and *Tayassuidae*), and of the families *Rhinocerotidae* and *Elephantidae*. (Model 'RUF');

(6) wild non-domestic animals of the order *Artiodactyla* (excluding bovine animals (including *Bison* and *Bubalus* species and their cross-breeds), *Ovis aries, Capra hircus, Suidae* and *Tayassuidae*), and of the families *Rhinocerotidae* and *Elephantidae* (Model 'RUW');

(7) farmed non-domestic animals belonging to the *Suidae, Tayassuidae*, or *Tapiridae* families (Model 'SUF');

(8) wild non-domestic animals belonging to the Suidae, Tayassuidae, or Tapiridae families (Model 'SUW');

(9) wild solipeds belonging to the subgenus Hippotigris (zebra) (Model 'EQW').

Fresh meat means all animal parts fit for human consumption whether fresh, chilled or frozen.
