Part II. Certification

I, the undersigned official veterinarian (name of exporting country) ⁽²⁾ hereby certify that:

II.1 The centre ⁽³⁾ described in Box I.11 at which the semen to be exported to Great Britain was stored:

II.2 The semen to be exported to Great Britain:

II.2.1 has been collected, processed and stored for a minimum period of 30 days immediately following collection in an approved semen collection centre ⁽⁴⁾ operated and supervised in accordance with Chapter I(I)(1) and Chapter I(II)(1) of Annex D to Directive 92/65/EEC, and

and has been imported to the exporting country under conditions at least as strict as for imports of semen of ovine and caprine species into Great Britain in accordance with Directive 92/65/EEC;]

II.2.2 was moved to the centre described in Part I.11 under conditions at least as strict as in Section A of those conditions described in the certificate for ovine and caprine semen from an approved collection centre ⁽⁵⁾;

II.2.3 was stored under conditions which satisfy the terms of Annex D to Directive 92/65/EEC;

II.2.4 was sent to the place of loading in a sealed container in accordance with point 1.4 of Chapter III(I) of Annex D to Directive 92/65/EEC and bearing the number indicated in Box I.23.

Notes

References to European Union legislation within this certificate are references to direct EU legislation which has been retained in Great Britain (retained EU law as defined in the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018) and can be viewed on the UK legislation website (legislation.gov.uk).

References to Great Britain in this certificate include Channel Islands and Isle of Man.

Part I:

- Box reference I.11: Place of origin shall correspond to the approved semen storage centre of dispatch of the semen.
- Box reference I.17: Shall correspond to the serial number of the individual official document(s) or health certificate(s) that accompanied the semen described above from the approved semen collection centre of its origin to the centre described in Box I.11. The original(s) of those document(s) or those certificate(s) or the officially endorsed copies of thereof must be attached to this certificate.
- Box reference I.22: Number of packages shall correspond to the number of containers.
- Box reference I.23: Identification of container and seal number shall be indicated.
- Box reference I.28: *Donor identity* shall correspond to the official identification of the animal.
Date of collection shall be indicated in the following format: dd/mm/yyyy.
Approval number of the centre shall correspond to the approval number of the approved semen collection centre in which the semen was collected.
