#### Statistical release

The latest provisional monthly energy production, consumption and prices statistics produced by the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy were released on 27 October 2022.

Energy production and consumption statistics are provided in total and by fuel and provide an analysis of the latest 3 months data compared to the same period a year earlier. Energy price statistics cover domestic price indices, prices of road fuels and petroleum products and comparisons of international road fuel prices.

# Energy production and consumption

Highlights for the 3-month period June 2022 to August 2022, compared to the same period a year earlier include:

- Primary energy consumption in the UK on a fuel input basis rose by 6.3%, with petroleum consumption increasing as lockdown restrictions eased. On a temperature adjusted basis consumption rose by 4.0%. (table ET 1.2 and table ET 3.13)
- Indigenous energy production rose by 11%, boosted by strong growth in gas production. (<u>table</u> <u>ET 1.1</u>)
- Gas exports up significantly; the UK has been playing a key role in supplying gas to Europe as it looks to move away from Russian gas. (table ET 4.3)
- Electricity generation by Major Power Producers up 17%, with coal down 14%, but gas up 24%, nuclear up 7.5% and renewables up 16% due to increased capacity and more favourable weather conditions.\* (table ET 5.4)
- Gas provided 50.2% of electricity generation by Major Power Producers, with renewables at 29.8%, nuclear at 17.7% and coal at 1.6%.\* (table ET 5.4)
- Low carbon share of electricity generation by Major Power Producers down 1.9 percentage points to 47.5%, whilst fossil fuel share up 2.0 percentage points to 52.0% and at the highest share since the 3 month period ending February 2019.\* (table ET 5.4)

\*Major Power Producers (MPPs) data published monthly, all generating companies data published quarterly.

### **Energy prices**

Highlights for October 2022 compared to September 2022:

Petrol down 4.3 pence per litre but diesel up 0.3 pence per litre. (table QEP 4.1.1)

Statistics on monthly production and consumption of coal, electricity, gas, oil and total energy include data for the UK for the period up to the end of August 2022.

Statistics on average temperatures, heating degree days, wind speeds, sun hours and rainfall include data for the UK for the period up to the end of September 2022.

Statistics on energy prices include retail price data for the UK for September 2022, and petrol & diesel data for October 2022, with EU comparative data for September 2022.
