JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 22 July 2022. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant \pounds 2,209.84 net.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £2,833.33 gross.
- 4. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to pay expenses in the net sum of £1594.34.
- 5. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to pay non-fungible tokens in the net sum of £5,709.60.
- 6. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to pay a bonus in the net sum of £10,000.
- 7. The respondent must pay the claimant £22,347.11 in total.
- 8. The hearing listed on **7 December 2022** is vacated.
