JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 22 July 2022. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £2,209.84 net.
3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £2,833.33 gross.
4. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to pay expenses in the net sum of £1594.34.
5. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to pay non-fungible tokens in the net sum of £5,709.60.
6. The respondent breached the contract of the claimant by failing to pay a bonus in the net sum of £10,000.
7. The respondent must pay the claimant **£22,347.11** in total.
8. The hearing listed on **7 December 2022** is vacated.
