### REMEDY JUDGMENT

BY CONSENT it is ordered that:

1. In compensation for the claims upheld by the Employment Tribunal, the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum agreed between the parties within 28 days of the date of this Judgment.
2. The issue of remedy be stayed for 28 days from the date of this Judgment and upon compliance with the above Orders, the Claimant must immediately confirm to the Tribunal that the remedy payment has been made by the Respondent and that the case can therefore be closed.
3. The Recoupment Regulations 1996 do not apply to any of the above sums as the Claimant has confirmed that she has not received any state benefits.

This payment will discharge all parties from further obligation, or claim, with the exception of those agreed between the parties.
