- how many vehicles and trailers you expect to test a year
- if you want to test hazardous or dangerous goods and how many you expect to test a year
- where the vehicles are currently being tested (include volumes and ATF locations if various sites used)
- · what testing duration and start times you need

You should also include your aspirations for the future, including:

- how many testing days you think you will need each week
- how many examiners per day your site can accommodate
- how many examiners you would you like per day
- if you want to carry out, out of hours testing on the evening and weekends
