I wish to send you my objections to the 200 extra houses that are proposed to be built alongside the 350 new houses on the Bloor site. They are as follows:-

1) The existing infrastructure and roads is already inadequate and this will make it worse. There is already a major congestion problem on Grove Hill leading down into Stansted and this would exacerbate it.

2) This is good agricultural ground which we should be using to grow our own food instead of importing it.

3) The local school and doctors' surgery are full and could not cope with 200 extra families.

4) Previous planning applications for this area have been refused by the Secretary of State because they were considered to be unsustainable.

5) It would adversely affect the rural quality of village life in both Henham and Elsenham.
