I would like to strongly object to the proposal to build an extra 200 houses as an add on to the 350 already agreed.

The villages will not be able to cope with the extra housing causing problems for the schools and doctors surgery which I believe are operating at maximum capacity thus having a knock on effect on residents.

The other major problem is the extra traffic getting in and out of the village on rural roads many of which have no lighting or footpaths and cannot satisfactorily accommodate further growth.

The biggest problem will be the route used by many who travel to Stansted & Bishops Stortford via Grove Hill which is a **Nightmare** due to being narrow and only allowing single file traffic either way, I dread to think what it will be like with the extra housing and cars.
