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I STRONGLY object to the application to add yet another 200 houses as a bolt on to the previously approved 350 on the Bloor site in Elsenham.

With a potential for 1000 houses approved or applied for how on earth can this application be approved by the Planning Inspectorate when in 2016 the Secretary of State refused permission for 800 properties stating that it was not sustainable.

He agreed with his inspector with regard to traffic congestion, the developers claim that Elsenham has excellent transport facilities however trying to navigate through Stansted Mountfitchet, the minor country roads via Ugley and the tiny North Hall Road towards Newport is a nightmare at present, with the addition of another 350 houses, it will become nigh on impossible.

Elsenham itself has very few amenities which necessitates villagers to travel to Bishops Stortford or Saffron Walden.
The bus service is very poor thus the need to travel by car.

I urge you to reject this application !!!!
