I wish to object to the above application.

I live in Henham, and already struggle to get to Stansted Mountfitchet by car due to the dangerously narrow road as one enters Stansted on Stansted Road. There is an equally dangerous section of road when leaving Elsenham heading towards Newport on North Hall Road.

Neither of these sections of road can be improved without multi million pound investments and compulsory purchases.

These 2 routes into Elsenham and Henham will be made considerably worse by the current development of 350 houses being built on the Bloor site. Any additional development would be a disaster, and a travesty, given the Secretary of State ruling in 2016 against 800 houses on land included within the current application.
