## **JUDGMENT**

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- On 04 October 2022 the respondent made an application to the Tribunal for the claim to be struck out on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37 (1)(d) of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013.
- 2. On 10 October 2022 the Tribunal wrote to the claimant asking them for any comments on the application. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 3. On 21 October 2022 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 04 November 2022 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 4. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
