JUDGMENT

1. The claim for wrongful dismissal is dismissed.
2. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the wages of the claimant of **£64,942.17** and shall pay to him that sum.
3. The respondent shall pay to the claimant **£1,078.80** in respect of untaken leave of 5.1 days which was outstanding at the end of his employment.
4. The claim for unauthorised deduction for the period up until 2 October 2020 is dismissed as it was not brought within time.
5. The claim for damages for breach of contract in respect of expenses is dismissed.
6. The claim for failure to provide itemised pay statements for December 2020, January 2021, December 2021, January 2022 and February 2022 is well founded.
