JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim that she was unfairly constructively dismissed is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The claimant's claim that she was subjected to direct discrimination because of disability under s 13 Equality Act 2010 is unsuccessful and is dismissed.
- 3. The claimant's claim that she was subject to discrimination arising form disability under s 15 Equality Act 2010 is unsuccessful and is dismissed.
- 4. The claimant's claim that the respondent failed to make reasonable adjustments is successful.
- 5. The claimant's claim for breach of contract (failure to pay notice pay) is dismissed
- 6. The claimant's claim for payment of holiday pay accrued on termination of her employment is successful.
- 7. Remedy will be determined at a subsequent hearing.
