I would like to strongly object to the the proposed application to the above address. Henham/Elsenham is already overpopulated with many sites already started or about to start with permission given.

Bloor Homes are already in the process of building 350 new homes in Elsenham and this application for a further 200 homes in just an add on to the existing 350 homes making a site containing 550 homes.

The secretary of state said in 2016 that the proposal of 800 dwellings on the same land was not sustainable .NOW HERE WE ARE IN 2022 LOOKING AT 550 HOMES ON THE SAME SITE AND HUNDREDS OF OTHER NEW BUILDS IN ELSENHAM HOW CAN THIS BE RIGHT.

Elsenham already suffers with serve traffic problems with inadequate roads to take more traffic.With a total of 550 homes with 2 cars per family means another 1100 motor vehicles on the roads.The roads cannot take this volume of traffic.The Cross at Elsenham and Grove Hill Stansted see lots of queuing traffic and very high levels of pollution .Hall Road the other main route out of the village is not even classed as a B road,this road sees many accidents and unfortunately 2 fatalities in the passed few weeks.

The local amenities are poor and the local school and doctors surgery are full to the brim.
