I object to further development for another 200 homes by Bloor Homes as a bolt on to the 350 houses already approved. The local roads linking Henham to Elsenham and Stansted are unsuitable for more traffic as local people, myself included, experience the daily queues through Elsenham to Grove Hill, Lower Street and Chapel Hill, as most people use this route to Bishops Stortford. The Ugley route is no better with twisting roads and no street lights. Elsenham primary school is full, doctors surgery the same. In these times of food shortages and global warming it makes sense to use high grade productive agricultural land for growing our own food and not importing it.
