For the urgent attention of the Planning Inspectorate regarding the proposed building of a further 200 houses on a Bloor site at Elsenham on Henham Parish Land.

We maintain that neither the roads, infrastructure, schooling or GP services can sustain such growth in an area that is struggling to provide services for the existing community.

The roads leading to and away from the local villages and communities are totally inadequate even for the existing amount of road users and claiming that public transport is “excellent” is just downright lies.

We urge you to reconsider the Bloor homes application in light of the difficulties already experienced by the residents of Henham, Elsenham, Ugley and Stansted Mountfitchit; and at the very least delay any further building work until the roads linking these communities to the main arterial routes have been upgraded accordingly.
