I wish to strongly object the building of yet more houses in Elsenham.

The area was put forward for planning permission a few years ago and was refused by the then Secretary of State as it was not sustainable. The situation has not changed.

The roads going south to Stansted and Bishop's Stortford and North to Saffron Walden are not suitable for even more traffic. They are single track in places with no footpaths. These roads just cannot take any more traffic both because of tail backs and safety. This has to be seen to be understood. Maps do not show where two cars cannot pass or where it is dangerous to walk.

There is no employment in the immediate area and few shops which means a further increase in daily travel.

The site is Grade 1 and Grade 2 land ,and is excellent land needed for farming.
