As a resident in the Elsenham/Henham area, we are now surrounded by ongoing new building, road closures and grid lock on all the roads in the area.
Quite frankly, we are at breaking point, as infrastructure, local services, schools and medical centres just cannot cope!

Grove Hill leading to Stansted Mountfitchet is now a no-go area at many times of the day with cars increasingly backed up due to heavy traffic and the one way traffic lights. This is now diverting traffic elsewhere along country roads which are falling apart.

Our local medical centre in Elsenham is at breaking point and is now facing desperate circumstances with the new builds already ongoing, let alone any new further pending applications.
