Please treat this email as our objection to the application to build a further 200 houses. This is clearly an attempt to shoehorn in another 200 houses to the 350 houses already approved on the Bloor site. The Secretary of State has already refused planning permission of 800 dwellings on land considered in the above application, stating that local infrastructure, roads, schools etc. cannot support this volume. Local schools are already full, many village roads surrounding the site have limited or no footpaths presenting a safety risk to anyone choosing to walk locally. Local traffic is often at grid lock with Chapel Hill, Grove Hill and New Hall Road having bottleneck access points. Severe traffic problem already in the area will only worsen and will increase the risk of injury and death of the local residents.
