Dear Sir or Madam,

Please register our objections to the application for 200 houses on this site. We consider that an additional 200 houses will place an unbearable burden on our road and transport system.

The site is in a rural area and will be built on Grade 1 and 2 agricultural land, the surrounding roads are narrow and ill equipped to accommodate additional traffic.

As there are limited shopping facilities in the area most people travel to the larger towns of Saffron Walden or Bishop's Stortford. Although there is a train and a bus service, these only run once an hour and the bus takes nearly an hour to get to Bishop's Stortford, so the reality is that most residents rely on their cars to travel.

In 2016 a proposal for 800 house was rejected by the Secretary of State due to the transport issues and since then the situation on the roads has become worse.
