

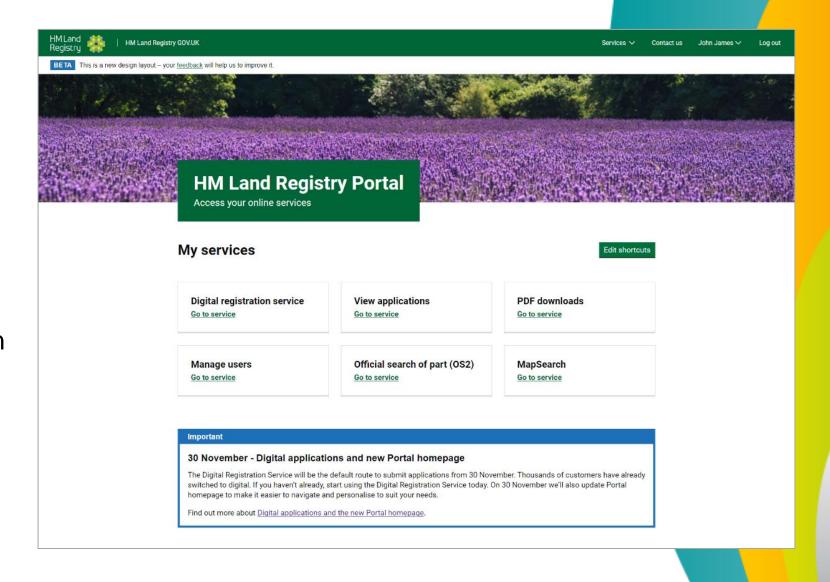

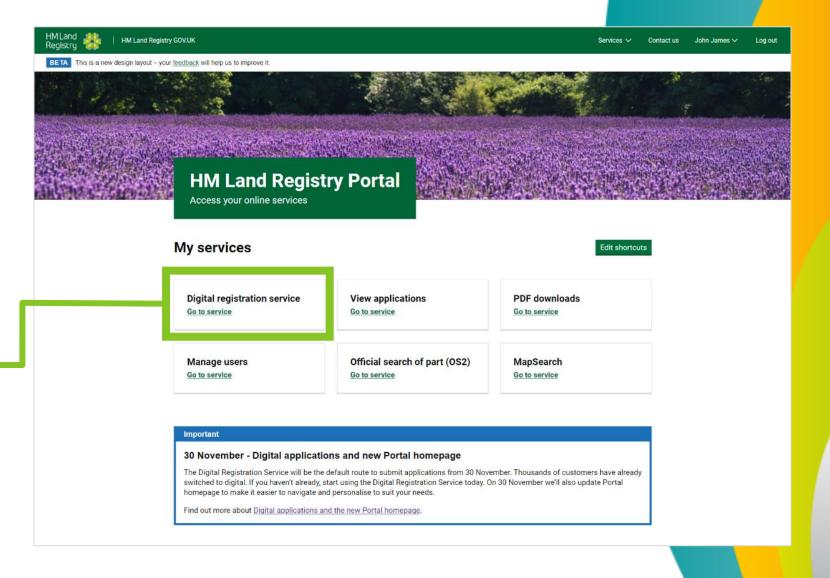


 This guide has been written to assist you in finding where to submit an application via the HM Land Registry portal following the homepage redesign



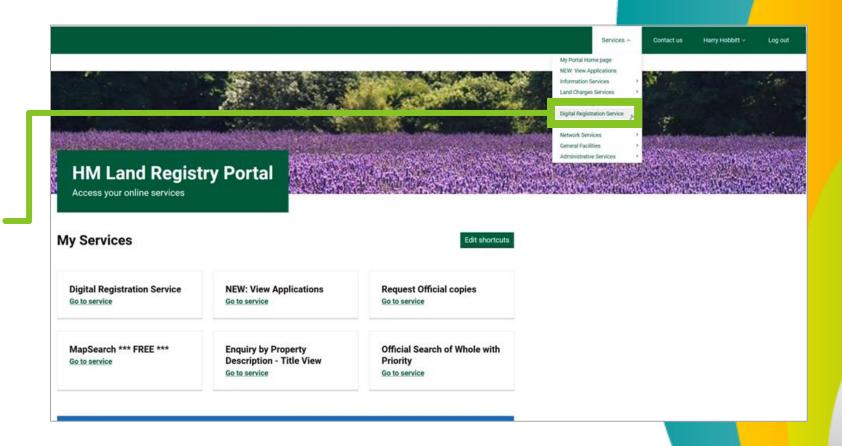


- Applications can be submitted using the Digital Registration Service
- There are two ways to access the Digital Registration Service:
 - The homepage, and...





...via the Services menu across the top menu



- The Digital Registration Service start page will guide you as to which service to use to submit your application
- There is a section at the top for applications that the Digital Registration Service will accept
- Along with when the legacy Document Registration Service should be used and a link to access
- The Digital Registration Service can be accessed with this button

Apply to update or create a registered title

Use this service to:

- · update registered titles
- · register new titles (including transfers of part and new leases)
- · close leasehold titles (including merger applications)
- · remove default Form A restrictions

You can only use this service for applications with up to 25 titles.

When to use a different service

You can submit the vast majority of applications using this service, but there are some things you cannot do yet.

You should continue to use the <u>document registration service</u> for applications to:

- · amend chargee name and address for service
- · register a transfer of charge or assent of charge
- · register appointments of new trustees
- register a transfer for value RTB/RTA (right to buy or acquire) or a transfer by operation of law on death
- register a discharge of part (DS3)
- register a consolidation of charge or sub charge
- · register lease extensions

You should also use the <u>document registration service</u> for applications with more than 25 titles. If your application has more than 50 titles, <u>contact the bulk application team</u>.

For first registrations (FR1), you should submit applications by post.
