

Procurement of the Housing Loss Prevention Advice Service in England and Wales from August 2023

Amendment Notice with effect from 30 November 2022

On 17 November 2022 the LAA published an invitation to tender HLPAS from 1 August 2023 on its eTendering system.

Further to the publication of that tender and following consultation with HMCTS, the LAA is amending the tender to:

- a) adding the relevant weightings for the Quality Award Criteria 1, to include the weightings for sub criteria 1.1.i, 1.1.ii and 1.1.iii and update description of sub criteria for 1.1i, 1.1ii, 1.1.iii , 1.2, 1.3 and 2.1;
- b) include Bury St Edmunds as a separate HLPAS Area

In accordance with paragraph 5.20 of the SQ IFA, we are amending the HLPAS IFA as follows:

1. Paragraph 7.8 of the HLPAS IFA: to include the breakdown for the Quality Award Criteria 1, to now include a breakdown of the sub criteria weighting for 1.1.i, 1.1.ii and 1.1.iii
