



Warrant to secure attendance at court

(issued under rule 81.7(2) of the Civil Procedure Rules)

To:

- the Tipstaff (if in the High Court), attending on His Majesty's High Court of Justice, their deputy or assistants, and
- all police constables whom it may concern
