The area forms part of Salisbury Plain Training Area. It forms part of the dry training area, offering an egress point in order to better exploit the western end of SPTA West. It enables the uninhibited deployment of troops and associated technical equipment at any time for repeated or extended periods of time. The area contributes to the planning flexibility of the units who train on SPTA, numbers of which continue to increase.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This forms part of the Salisbury Plain Training Area which is used for military training, including armoured and infantry. Public access is available along adjacent PROW. This arrangement provides adequate separation between the general public and troops training.</li> <li>There are occasions where the military requirement is to utilise an area which requires exclusivity to ensure public safety and training efficiency, especially when new equipment is in the process of procurement.</li> <li>Some units conduct certain training practices, occasionally require a safer place, where no public is allowed.</li> <li>MOD intends to modify the Byelaws to include this small additional area plus other recent land purchases at Heytesbury under the current Byelaw Review Programme. This will result in this parcel of land being excepted from CROW access legislation. Any changes in byelaws will be subject to public consultation.</li> </ol>
