JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

(i) The claimant succeeds in her claim for unlawful deduction from wages for the value of the sunglasses. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £300 net. Her claim for unlawful deduction from wages for the General Optical Council fees does not succeed.

(ii) The claimant's claim for breach of contract in respect of parking expenses does not succeed and is dismissed
