## **JUDGMENT**

The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is that:

- (1) The claim for disability-related harassment is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- (2) The claim for unauthorised deductions of wages (paid special leave) is dismissed as being out of time.
- (3) In respect of the claims for unauthorised deductions of wages for which the responded conceded liability, the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum £103.50 (i.e. 7.5 hours paid at the hourly rate of £13.75) having accounted to HMRC for any tax and national insurance contributions due.
- (4) The remaining claims for unauthorised deductions are dismissed on the claimant's withdrawal.
