JUDGMENT

- 1. The Employment Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider the Claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal because the complaint was presented after the end of the period of three months beginning with the effective date of termination, and it was reasonably practicable for the complaint to be presented before the end of that period of three months (section 111, Employment Rights Act 1996).
