1 Route Definition

- 1.1 Services shall be provided between London Paddington and Swindon calling at Reading.
- 1.2 Limited Stops shall be made at Didcot Parkway.
- 1.3 Services may be provided by those specified in other Routes
- 1.4 Additional services between London Paddington and Reading/Didcot Parkway are specified in other Routes.

2 Frequency

2.1 Mondays to Fridays

- (a) Between and including the Early Service and the Late Service, 81 services from London Paddington shall be provided at 30-minute intervals.
