JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction of wages for 5 weeks unpaid wages succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £783.
- 2. The claimant's complaint of accrued holiday pay is well founded and succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £93.96 for 12 days accrued but untaken.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract and is entitled to damages of £313.20 in respect of two weeks notice pay.
- 4. The claimant is entitled to a statutory redundancy payment of £469.80.
- 5. This sum(s) payable under paragraphs 1 & 2 above are the gross amount to be paid and the claimant is to be responsible for any income tax and National Insurance Contributions thereon.
