JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that

1. The Employment Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to entertain the complaint of Unfair Dismissal. The complaint is dismissed.
2. The claimant has failed to particularise her complaint for failure to pay accrued and untaken holiday pay which is dismissed.

3. The claimant's complaint of breach of contract does not succeed and is dismissed.
4. The respondent made a limited number of unlawful deductions from pay. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the unlawfully deducted Case Number 1301009/2019

pay in the gross sum of £142.90.
