1 Agenda item – Welcome and Introduction

1.1 Water Resources and Flood Risk Specialist as Chair, HS2 asked all attendees to introduce themselves and went through the agenda, Senior Technical Engagement Manager took attendees through housekeeping.

2 Agenda item - What is Happening

2.1 Senior Technical Engagement Manager gave a project overview on what is happening on Phase 2B. Chair also presented a diagram of the Hybrid Bill process, the Phase 2b programme and shared helpful links.

Questions and discussion

Manchester City Council asked HS2 if the GIS data link includes all the data for the Bill

The Chair, HS2 advised that the GIS data link does not include data from Additional Provision 1 (AP1)

Manchester City Council raised concern about HS2 ensuring the GIS data for AP2 is on the website in time when that comes into play

3 Agenda item - Terms of Reference (ToR) Approval

3.1 Senior Technical Engagement Manager took attendees through the Terms of Reference.

Questions and discussion

Manchester City Council queried if this subgroup will be responsible for shaping the Environmental Minimum Requirements (EMRs) to a degree during the parliamentary process.

The Chair, HS2 advised that the discussions on EMRs will come out of this group, any U&A which is put into writing will be taken out of this group as it goes beyond the technical team. But the actual EMRs itself will come out of here
