

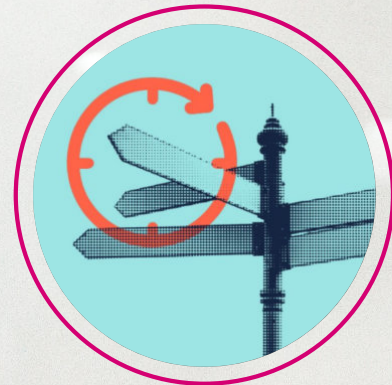


National AI Strategy

Published the AI Regulation Policy Paper and received stakeholder feedback through a call-for-views



The Centre for Data Ethics and Innovation published the 'Industry Temperature Check: Barriers and Enablers to AI Assurance' report



The Alan Turing Institute launched the AI Standards Hub in collaboration with BSI and NPL, and supported by DCMS



Published the first AI Action Plan, which outlines new priorities for the year ahead



£117 million towards 1,000 new PhDs in AI through UKRI AI Centres for Doctoral Training



£17 million towards 2,000 new AI and Data Science Conversion Courses Scholarships



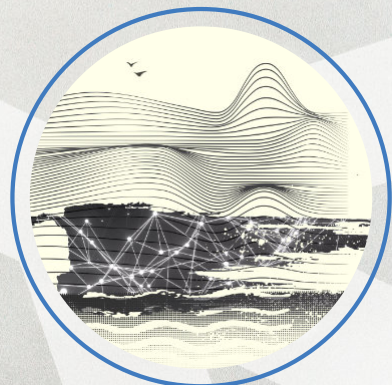
The Ministry of Defence published the Defence AI Strategy

£1.5 million BEIS funding towards 'The AI for Decarbonisation' programme, to speed up the development of AI tech to help reduce emissions

Tech Nation's Applied AI 4.0 kicked-off supporting 35 innovative companies to scale and grow



£8.5 million towards the AHRC 'Enabling a Responsible AI Ecosystem' programme
