| | Merger control |
| | Under the merger control regime, the CMA considers the facts and circumstances specific to the case under the relevant statutory tests. The outcome of each case is in relation to the individual companies related to the merger in question. The CMA cannot set policy for markets through our mergers work. During the reporting period (17/12/2021 to 16/12/2022): At Phase 1, we made 13 references to Phase 2 (1 of which followed a report to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy under public interest ground of national security, which was subsequently referred back to the CMA for a phase 2 in-depth investigation on the grounds of national security concerns), 14 unconditional clearances, 1 de minimis clearance and 13 sets of Undertakings in Lieu of a Reference decision. 2 cases resulted in a report to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy under public interest ground of national security (where he accepted statutory undertakings from the parties involved and was therefore not referred back to the CMA for a further assessment). 4 cases were found not to qualify and 1 case abandoned. 7 cases were ongoing at the end of the reporting period. (5 of which are currently awaiting a final outcome where an SLC has been found). |
| | At Phase 2, we cleared 3 cases and found a substantial lessening of competition (SLC) in 9 cases (which includes 1 remittal). 3 cases were abandoned. From the cases where we found an SLC there were 3 prohibitions and 6 impositions of remedies by divestment. 4 cases were ongoing at the end of the reporting period. |
