# Statistical release

The latest provisional monthly energy production, consumption and prices statistics produced by the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy were released on 22 December 2022.

Energy production and consumption statistics are provided in total and by fuel and provide an analysis of the latest 3 months data compared to the same period a year earlier. Energy price statistics cover domestic price indices, prices of road fuels and petroleum products and comparisons of international road fuel prices.

## Energy production and consumption

Highlights for the 3-month period August 2022 to October 2022, compared to the same period a year earlier include:

• Primary energy consumption in the UK on a fuel input basis fell by 0.3%, with petroleum consumption increasing as international travel restrictions eased but with gas consumption dropping. On a temperature adjusted basis consumption fell by 1.9%. (<u>table ET 1.2</u> and <u>table ET 3.13</u>)

• Indigenous energy production fell by 6.1%, due to a large fall in oil production as a result of planned maintenance. (<u>table ET 1.1</u>)

• Russian imports continue to decrease. The UK has not imported any Russian gas since March 2022, and Russian oil imports accounted for just 0.7% of total oil imports in the latest 3 months of 2022, down from 9.9% last year. (table ET 4.4 and table ET 3.14)

• Gas exports up significantly; the UK has been playing a key role in supplying gas to Europe as it looks to move away from Russian gas. (<u>table ET 4.3</u>)

• Electricity generation by Major Power Producers up 14%, with coal down 1.8%, but gas up 23%, nuclear broadly unchanged and renewables up 13% due to increased capacity and more favourable weather conditions, with offshore wind generation in October 2022 at a record high monthly level.\* (table ET 5.4)

• Gas provided 46.6% of electricity generation by Major Power Producers, with renewables at 35.6%, nuclear at 15.2% and coal at 1.7%.\* (<u>table ET 5.4</u>)

• Low carbon share of electricity generation by Major Power Producers down 2.8 percentage points to 50.8%, whilst fossil fuel share up 2.9 percentage points to 48.7%.\* (<u>table ET 5.4</u>)

\*Major Power Producers (MPPs) data published monthly, all generating companies data published quarterly.

### Energy prices

Highlights for December 2022 compared to November 2022:

• Petrol down 8.9 pence per litre and diesel down 9.3 pence per litre. (table QEP 4.1.1)

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#### Data periods and coverage

Statistics on monthly production and consumption of coal, electricity, gas, oil and total energy include data for the UK for the period up to the end of October 2022.

Statistics on average temperatures, heating degree days, wind speeds, sun hours and rainfall include data for the UK for the period up to the end of November 2022.

Statistics on energy prices include retail price data for the UK for November 2022, and petrol & diesel data for December 2022, with EU comparative data for November 2022.
