JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

REASONS

- 1. On 07 October 2022 the Tribunal wrote to the claimant reminding them to comply with the Case Management Order set out at paragraph 3 of the Note following a Preliminary Hearing dated 20 September 2022. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 2. On 08 November 2022 the Tribunal wrote to the claimant reminding them to reply to the earlier letter dated 07 October 2022. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 3. On 17 November 2022 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 02 December 2022 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 4. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
