## **ORAL JUDGMENT**

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The respondent made an unauthorised deduction of wages by failing to pay the claimant her wages for April, July and August 2022, and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £5811 net.
- 2. The respondent failed to pay the claimant 2 weeks' contractual notice pay on termination of her contract, and the respondent ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £894 net.

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3. The claimant is entitled to be paid in lieu of 14 days' holiday outstanding at the

date of termination, and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of

£1251.60 net.

4. The claimant is entitled to be paid in lieu of 20 days' holiday carried over from the

holiday year 1 January to 31 December 2020, it being not reasonably practicable

for her to have taken this holiday due to the effects of coronavirus, and the

respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £1788 (net).

5. The claim for expenses is dismissed upon withdrawal.
