- I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, certify that the meat described above meets the following conditions:
- (a) the meat was derived from animals which were born and reared only in the United Kingdom;
- (b) the animals from which meat was obtained were subject to ante mortem inspection under official veterinary supervision, where no clinical evidence of notifiable infectious or contagious disease was noted;
- (c) the animals from which the meat was derived were examined under official veterinary supervision immediately after slaughter and found fit for human consumption in accordance with Regulations currently in force in the United Kingdom;
- (d) the animals were slaughtered and the meat prepared in an establishment approved by the competent authorities of the United Kingdom;
- (e) the animals from which the meat was derived did not come from holdings under restrictions for foot and mouth disease and/or rinderpest, being epizootic diseases to which the animal species is susceptible;
- (f) The United Kingdom is recognised by the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH) as a country free from foot and mouth disease;
- (g) the meat has been produced, handled, stored and transported within the United Kingdom in such a way to prevent contact or comminglement with any animal products that do not originate in the United Kingdom;
- (h) the meat is acceptable for human consumption in the United Kingdom;
- (i) the meat was produced in accordance with the National residue monitoring programme in the United Kingdom and contains no harmful levels of veterinary drugs, pesticides or contaminants.
