JUDGMENT

1. No response on a prescribed form was entered and accordingly liability Judgment is entered in default pursuant to Rule 21 (Schedule 1, Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013).
2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £1,955.56 gross, for wages unpaid between 2 and 22 October 2022 as follows:
 - Week commencing 2 October 2022 £844.13,
 - Week commencing 9 October 2022 £775.13 and
 - Week commencing 16 October 2022 £336.30.The Claimant shall be responsible for accounting to HMRC for his tax.
3. The Respondent is further ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £240 pursuant to section 24(2) Employment Rights Act 1996, in relation to financial loss sustained by the Claimant which is attributable to the unlawful deductions from his wages.
