## **JUDGMENT**

**Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21** 

- 1. The claim was issued in the London South Employment Tribunals on **17 March 2022**. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages for 2 months and must pay the claimant £9,570.00 gross.
- 3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £875.00 gross.
- 4. The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant £210.00 gross representing unpaid pension employer contributions.
- 5. The claim for breach of contract in respect of expenses is well founded. The respondent is ordered to pay compensation of £150.35 gross.
- 6. The respondent must pay the claimant £10,805.35 in total.
- 7. The claimant is responsible for any figures owed to HMRC in respect of tax or national insurance contributions.
