JUDGMENT on RECONSIDERATION

- 1. The Claimant has applied by letter dated 18 August 2022 (email timed at 10:21) to seek reconsideration of the amount awarded by way of a Preparation Time Order.
- 2. The Application for Reconsideration is rejected in accordance with Rule 72(1) on the basis that there is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked.
- 3. Under Rule 79 of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013, the hourly rate for a Preparation Time Order (the appropriate rate where a party is unrepresented or is represented by a Lay Representative) was, in August 2022 £23 per hour.
- 3. I considered that the appropriate length of time for which the Claimant should be compensated by way of a Preparation Time Order, to be four and a half hours. I rounded the figure off at £145 as the amount of a Preparation Time Order and consider that to be a just and equitable sum.
- 4. The Claimant, by the email of 18 August 2022, appears to be seeking all of her costs. The Preparation Time Order was made in relation to a previous Hearing of 5 May 2022. No other costs or Preparation Time Order was made in favour of the Claimant.
