## JUDGMENT

1. There had been an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages as the claimant was not paid one week's pay following his resignation.
2. The respondent is, therefore, ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £370.78 net for having made an unauthorised deduction from his wages following the termination of his employment.
3. The case proceeded in the respondent's absence as there was no evidence medical or otherwise, that it was unable to participate in this hearing.
