## JUDGMENT

The respondent's breach of contract claim is struck out.

## REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated **15 November 2022** to the respondent and to an organisation called Natwest Mentor Legal Protection (which the Tribunal understands may be the respondent's representative) the Tribunal informed the respondent that its breach of contract claim was inadequately pleaded and could not be sensibly responded to. The respondent was provided with an opportunity to provide further information including specifying to the amounts claimed and how those amounts have been calculated.
- 2. By letter dated 8 December 2022 the Tribunal informed the respondent that its breach of contract claim may be struck out in the event that required detail was not provided.
- 3. No further information has been received by the respondent.
- 4. the respondent has not complied with the Orders of the Tribunal as stated in the letters from the Tribunal dated 15 November 2022 and 8 December 2022.
- 5. The respondent has not actively pursued its breach of contract claim
- 6. The respondent has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why the breach of contract claim should not be struck out or to request a hearing. The respondent's breach of contract claim is therefore struck out.
