JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant the sum of £10,748.88. This sum is comprised of:

Prescribed element:

- 2. Previous net average pay from 3 January 2022 until 4 April 2022 (12 weeks) = £4,595.26.
- 3. Difference between previous net average pay and new net average pay from 5 April until 13 December (36 weeks) = £1,107.69.
- 4. The total is £5,702.95. This is subject to an increase of 25% for the Respondent's breach of the ACAS Code of Practice on Disciplinary and Grievance Procedures. The total is therefore increased to £7,128.69.

Non-prescribed element:

- 5. Future losses of difference between previous net average pay and new net average pay for 26 weeks = £800.00.
- 6. Loss of pension contributions = $\pounds173.08$.
- 7. Loss of statutory rights, healthcare, dental, and pension benefits = \pounds 1,923.08.
- 8. The total is £2,896.15. This is subject to an increase of 25% for the

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Respondent's breach of the ACAS Code of Practice on Disciplinary and Grievance Procedures. The total is therefore increased to £3,620.19.

- 9. For the purposes of Regulation 4 of the Employment Protection (Recoupment of Benefits) Regulations 1996:
 - a. The Prescribed Element is £7,128.69.
 - b. The Prescribed Period is 3 January 2022 and 13 December 2022.
 - c. The total monetary award is £10,748.88.
 - d. The excess of the total monetary award over the Prescribed Element is £3,620.19
