## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The complaint that the Claimant was unfairly dismissed under the Employment Rights Act 1996 is struck out.
- 2. Her claim that she was subject to discrimination leading to her decision to resign continues under the Equality Act 2010.

## **REASONS**

- 1. The Claimant complains of unfair dismissal.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a Claimant to have not less than two years' service to make an unfair dismissal complaint.
- 3. The Claimant was employed by the Respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the Claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The Claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why that complaint should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out.
- 7. The Claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment, including that she was discriminated against under the Equality Act 2010.
