JUDGMENT

The Employment Judge gave Judgment as follows;

1. The complaint that the 1st Respondent failed to comply with the requirement of section 188 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 is well founded.
2. The Employment Judge makes a Protective Award in respect of the Claimant who was employed at the 1st Respondents premises at 3 Trent Lane, Weston on Trent, Derby DE72 2BT and was dismissed as redundant on 30 November 2021 as an Electrical Engineer.

3. The Employment Judge orders the 1st Respondent to pay to the Claimant remuneration for a protected period of 90 days beginning on 30 November 2021.
